World Mini Mini Football (WMMF) Statute



2025



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PREAMBLE

The World Mini Mini Football Federation (WMMF) is the international governing body of World Mini Mini Football and exists to promote, regulate, develop, and govern the sport worldwide.

CHAPTER I – GENERAL PROVISIONS

Article 1 – Name

1.1 The name of the organization shall be the **World Mini Mini Football Federation**, hereinafter referred to as **WMMF**.

1.2 WMMF shall serve as the international governing body responsible for the administration, regulation, development, promotion, and protection of the sport of World Mini Mini Football.

1.3 WMMF shall operate in accordance with its Statutes, Regulations, policies, and directives and may conduct its activities throughout the world through recognized Member Associations, affiliated entities, and authorized representatives.

1.4 The abbreviation **WMMF** and all associated names, titles, marks, and identifiers relating to the Federation shall be protected and administered by WMMF.

Article 2 – Authority

2.1 WMMF shall be the supreme international governing authority of World Mini Mini Football and shall have exclusive jurisdiction over the administration, regulation, development, and promotion of the sport worldwide.

2.2 WMMF shall establish and enforce the official Rules of the Game, competition regulations, disciplinary provisions, and all other policies governing the sport.

2.3 WMMF shall have the authority to recognize Member Associations, sanction competitions, appoint officials, establish rankings, and oversee all international matters relating to World Mini Mini Football.

2.4 All recognized Member Associations, athletes, teams, officials, and participants operating under the jurisdiction of WMMF shall respect and comply with the Statutes, Regulations, decisions, and directives issued by WMMF.

2.5 No organization or entity may claim international governing authority over World Mini Mini Football without the recognition and authorization of WMMF.

Article 3 – Ownership of the Sport

WMMF shall own and administer:

- a) The sport of World Mini Mini Football;
- b) The Rules of the Game;
- c) Official competitions;
- d) Rankings and records;
- e) Intellectual property relating to the sport



Article 4 – Objectives

WMMF shall:

- a) Develop and promote the sport worldwide;
- b) Organize international competitions;
- c) Recognize national governing bodies;
- d) Protect the integrity of the sport;
- e) Promote fair play and safeguarding.

CHAPTER II – MEMBERSHIP

Article 5 – Member Associations

5.1 WMMF may recognize one Member Association (MA) in each country, territory, or region as determined by WMMF.

5.2 A recognized Member Association shall be the official governing body of World Mini Mini Football within the region for which recognition has been granted.

5.3 Recognition shall be granted, maintained, suspended, or withdrawn solely at the discretion of WMMF and in accordance with its Statutes and Regulations.

Article 6 – Rights and Duties of Member Associations

6.1 Recognized Member Associations shall have the right to participate in WMMF activities, competitions, meetings, development programs, and other initiatives approved by WMMF.

6.2 Member Associations shall:

- a) Govern and promote the sport within the region for which recognition has been granted;
- b) Comply with and enforce the WMMF Statutes, Competition Rules, Regulations, policies, and directives;
- c) Participate in WMMF activities and support the objectives of WMMF;
- d) Maintain appropriate governance, integrity, and safeguarding standards;
- e) Submit information, reports, and other documentation requested by WMMF.

6.3 Member Associations shall act in a manner that protects the interests, reputation, and development of World Mini Mini Football.

Article 7 – Suspension and Withdrawal of Recognition

7.1 WMMF may suspend or withdraw recognition from any Member Association that violates these Statutes, WMMF Competition Rules, Regulations, or any directive lawfully issued by WMMF.

7.2 Grounds for suspension or withdrawal may include, but are not limited to:

- a) Serious breaches of governance or integrity standards;
- b) Failure to comply with WMMF regulations;
- c) Conduct that brings the sport or WMMF into disrepute;
- d) Inactivity or failure to fulfill membership obligations.

7.3 A suspended or withdrawn Member Association shall lose such rights and privileges as determined by WMMF until its status is restored or otherwise decided by WMMF.



CHAPTER III – GOVERNANCE

Article 8 – Governing Bodies

The governing bodies of WMMF shall be:

- a) Founder
- b) President
- c) Chief Executive Officer
- d) Board of Directors
- e) Vice Presidents

Article 9 – Founder

9.1 The Founder shall be the supreme authority of WMMF and shall safeguard the ownership, integrity, development, and governance of the sport of World Mini Mini Football.

9.2 The Founder shall have the authority to appoint and remove:

- a) The President;
- b) The Chief Executive Officer (CEO);
- c) Vice Presidents;
- d) Members of the Executive Board;
- e) Committee Chairpersons;
- f) Any other officers deemed necessary for the administration of WMMF.

9.3 The Founder shall have the authority to approve the establishment of Member Associations, Continental Confederations, subsidiary companies, and other entities operating under WMMF.

9.4 The Founder shall have the authority to approve or reject amendments affecting:

- a) Ownership of the sport;
- b) Intellectual property rights;
- c) Recognition authority;
- d) Founder Protection provisions;
- e) The governance structure of WMMF.

9.5 The Founder may delegate powers to the President, Chief Executive Officer, Board of Directors, or other authorized persons, while retaining ultimate authority over matters reserved under these Statutes.

9.6 The Founder shall have the authority to issue directives necessary for the protection and development of WMMF and the sport of World Mini Mini Football.

9.7 The powers granted under this Article shall remain in force unless otherwise provided by these Statutes.

Article 10 – President

10.1 The President shall be the highest appointed representative of WMMF.

10.2 The President shall preside over Executive Board meetings, and official ceremonies of WMMF.

10.3 The President shall represent the unity, values, and interests of WMMF.



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10.4 The President may represent WMMF at official functions, meetings, and international events. In the event that the President is unavailable, the President shall designate the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) to represent WMMF on his/her behalf.

10.5 The President shall not be responsible for the day-to-day administration or operational management of WMMF.

Article 11 – Chief Executive Officer

11.1 The Chief Executive Officer shall be the second highest appointed representative of WMMF.

11.2 The Chief Executive Officer (CEO) shall be the chief executive and administrative officer of WMMF.

11.3 The CEO shall be responsible for the administration, management, strategic development of WMMF and Committees.

11.4 The CEO shall implement the Statutes, Rules & Regulations and decision approved by Founder.

11.5 The CEO shall oversee all operational, commercial, financial, and administrative activities of WMMF.

11.6 The CEO shall supervise staff, consultants, contractors, and subsidiary entities established by WMMF.

11.7 The CEO shall represent WMMF in commercial, contractual, and operational matters as authorized by the Founder.

11.8 The CEO shall prepare strategic plans, annual reports, budgets, and development programs for consideration by the President and ultimate approval by the Founder.

11.9 The CEO may appoint or recommend administrative personnel subject to applicable regulations and the Founder's approval.

11.10 The CEO shall report regularly to the President and the Founder regarding the activities and performance of WMMF.

Article 12 – Executive Board

12.1 The Executive Board shall serve as the advisory body of WMMF and shall support the achievement of the Federation's objectives.

12.2 Members of the Executive Board shall be appointed and removed by the Founder in accordance with these Statutes.

12.3 The Executive Board shall provide strategic guidance, oversight, recommendations, and support regarding the governance, development and long-term growth of WMMF.

12.4 The Executive Board may review policies, regulations, development programs, commercial initiatives, and other matters referred to it by the Founder, President, or Chief Executive Officer.

12.5 The Executive Board shall act in the best interests of WMMF and the sport of World Mini Mini Football and shall uphold the principles of integrity, transparency, and good governance.

12.6 The Executive Board shall perform such additional duties and responsibilities as may be assigned by the Founder.



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Article 13 – Vice Presidents

13.1 WMMF may appoint up to 5 Vice Presidents to assist in the promotion of the Federation.

13.2 Vice Presidents shall be appointed for a 4-year term and shall serve in such capacities.

13.3 Vice Presidents shall assist the Founder, President, Chief Executive Officer, and Executive Board in carrying out the objectives and activities of WMMF.

13.4 Vice Presidents may be assigned responsibility for specific regions, projects, committees, competitions, development programs, or other areas of activity as determined by WMMF.

13.5 Vice Presidents shall perform such additional duties and responsibilities as may be assigned by the Founder, President, or Chief Executive Officer.

CHAPTER IV – COMPETITIONS

Article 14 – Official Competitions

14.1 WMMF shall have the exclusive authority to sanction, recognize, organize, regulate, and govern official national and international World Mini Mini Football competitions.

14.2 Official competitions may include World Championships, Continental Championships, National Championships, Cups, Leagues, Ranking Events, Development Events, and any other competitions approved by WMMF.

14.3 All official competitions shall be conducted in accordance with the WMMF Statutes, Competition Rules, Regulations, and directives issued by WMMF.

14.4 WMMF may delegate the organization or hosting of competitions to Member Associations, Continental Confederations, organizing committees, or other authorized entities, while retaining overall governing authority and regulatory control.

14.5 Only competitions sanctioned or recognized by WMMF may be designated as official World Mini Mini Football competitions.

Article 15 – Competition Rules

All competitions shall be conducted in accordance with WMMF Competition Rules.

CHAPTER V – ETHICS, DISCIPLINE AND SAFEGUARDING

Article 16 – Ethics, Integrity and Fair Play

16.1 All participants involved in World Mini Mini Football shall conduct themselves with honesty, integrity, respect, and fair play at all times.

16.2 Athletes, coaches, officials, referees, administrators, Member National Associations, and all other participants shall uphold the principles of fair play, ethical conduct, integrity, transparency, and mutual respect both on and off the field of play.



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16.3 Any form of match manipulation, cheating, corruption, bribery, fraud, discrimination, harassment, abuse, safeguarding violations, unsporting conduct, or behavior that may bring the sport or WMMF into disrepute is strictly prohibited.

16.4 All participants shall respect the Rules of the Game, competition regulations, decisions of match officials, and the authority of WMMF.

16.5 WMMF shall promote a culture of integrity, inclusivity, respect, safeguarding, accountability, and fair competition throughout all its activities, competitions, and events.

Article 17 – Safeguarding

17.1 WMMF shall promote and maintain safeguarding measures to protect children, young persons, and vulnerable participants involved in World Mini Mini Football.

17.2 All Member Associations, athletes, coaches, officials, volunteers, and other participants shall contribute to creating a safe, respectful, and inclusive sporting environment free from abuse, harassment, neglect, exploitation, discrimination, racism and misconduct.

17.3 WMMF may establish safeguarding policies, procedures, and educational programs and may take appropriate action where safeguarding concerns arise.

17.4 All participants shall comply with applicable safeguarding regulations and cooperate with safeguarding investigations and procedures conducted under the authority of WMMF.

Article 18 – Disciplinary Sanctions

18.1 Any individual or entity found to have violated the Statutes, regulations, codes, policies, decisions, or ethical standards of WMMF may be subject to disciplinary sanctions.

18.2 Sanctions shall be proportionate to the nature, severity, and circumstances of the violation.

18.3 Available sanctions may include, but are not limited to:

- a) Written warning;
- b) Reprimand or formal censure;
- c) Temporary suspension from activities, events, meetings, or office;
- d) Removal from any elected, appointed, or administrative position within WMMF;
- e) financial penalties where permitted by applicable regulations;
- f) Suspension or withdrawal of membership rights;
- g) Lifetime ban from participation in WMMF activities in cases involving serious safeguarding violations, corruption, match manipulation, abuse, fraud, or conduct that fundamentally damages the integrity or reputation of WMMF.

18.4 The imposition of disciplinary sanctions shall not prevent WMMF from taking additional legal, contractual, or regulatory action where appropriate.

18.5 Decisions imposing sanctions shall be communicated in writing and may be subject to appeal in accordance with the procedures established by WMMF.

Article 19 – Investigations

19.1 The Governance, Ethics & Safeguarding Committee shall be responsible for investigating alleged violations of the Statutes, regulations, codes, and policies of WMMF.



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19.2 Investigations shall be conducted fairly, impartially, confidentially, and in accordance with the principles of due process.

19.3 Serious matters involving safeguarding, corruption, match manipulation, financial misconduct, abuse of authority, or other significant violations may be referred to an independent disciplinary or review panel.

19.4 The Committee may recommend provisional measures where necessary to protect participants, competitions, or the integrity of WMMF pending the outcome of an investigation.

Article 20 – Anti-Doping

WMMF follows international anti-doping standards and promotes clean sport.

Article 21 – Match Manipulation

21.1 Prohibition of Match Manipulation

Any form of match manipulation, match-fixing, or improper influence over the result, progress, conduct, or any aspect of a match is strictly prohibited.

21.2 Prohibited Conduct

No participant shall directly or indirectly:

- a)** Offer, promise, give, request, solicit, receive, or accept any financial or other benefit intended to influence a match or competition outcome.
- b)** Deliberately influence the result, score, timing, events, or performance of a match for an improper purpose.
- c)** Conspire with any individual or organization to manipulate any aspect of a competition.
- d)** Attempt to manipulate a match, regardless of whether the attempt is successful.

21.3 Duty to Report

All participants have an obligation to immediately report any approach, request, offer, threat, or information relating to potential match manipulation to WMMF.

21.4 Cooperation with Investigations

Participants shall fully cooperate with any investigation conducted by WMMF and shall provide truthful information, documentation, and evidence when requested.

21.5 Confidentiality

Reports of suspected match manipulation shall be treated confidentially to the greatest extent possible, while allowing proper investigation and disciplinary proceedings.

21.6 Disciplinary Measures

Any participant found guilty of match manipulation or related misconduct shall be subject to disciplinary sanctions, including suspension, expulsion, disqualification from competitions, forfeiture of results, fines, and any other measures deemed appropriate by WMMF.

21.7 Referral to Authorities

Where applicable, WMMF may refer matters involving match manipulation, fraud, corruption, or criminal conduct to the relevant law enforcement or governmental authorities.

CHAPTER VI – COMMERCIAL RIGHTS

Article 22 – Commercial Authority

WMMF shall own all commercial rights relating to the sport.



Article 23 – Subsidiary Companies

WMMF may establish or control commercial entities, including companies, for event management, media, licensing, sponsorship, merchandising, and other business activities.

Article 24 – Separation of Authority

All sporting authority shall remain exclusively vested in WMMF and shall not transfer to any commercial entity.

CHAPTER VII – FOUNDER PROTECTION

Article 22– Founder Authority

22.1 The Founder shall retain ultimate authority to safeguard the ownership, integrity, development, governance, and independence of World Mini Mini Football and WMMF.

22.2 The Founder shall have the authority to appoint and remove the President, Chief Executive Officer (CEO), Vice Presidents, members of the Executive Board, committee chairpersons, and such other officers as may be required for the administration of WMMF.

22.3 The Founder shall have the authority to approve the recognition, suspension, withdrawal, or replacement of Member Associations and Continental Confederations.

22.4 The Founder may issue directives, policies, and decisions necessary for the protection, development, and administration of WMMF and the sport of World Mini Mini Football.

22.5 The Founder may delegate powers and responsibilities, in writing, to the President, CEO, Executive Board, committees, or other authorized persons while retaining the powers reserved under these Statutes.

22.6 The Founder shall act as the guardian of the sport and shall take all reasonable measures necessary to preserve its identity, values, governance structure, and long-term development.

Article 23 – Protected Matters

23.1 The following matters shall be deemed protected matters and may not be transferred, assigned, amended, sold, licensed in perpetuity, surrendered, or otherwise altered without the prior written approval of the Founder:

- a) Ownership of the sport of World Mini Mini Football;
- b) Ownership and administration of the Rules of the Game;
- c) Recognition authority over Member Associations and Continental Confederations;
- d) The name "World Mini Mini Football" and the acronym "WMMF";
- e) WMMF trademarks, logos, brands, and intellectual property;
- f) World Championships and other official WMMF competitions;
- g) The governance structure of WMMF;
- h) Founder Protection provisions contained within these Statutes;
- i) Any rights or assets considered fundamental to the identity or independence of WMMF.

23.2 No person, organization, sponsor, investor, commercial entity, Member Association, or third party shall acquire ownership, governing authority, or controlling interest over the sport of World Mini Mini Football.



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23.3 Any action, agreement, amendment, transaction, or decision that conflicts with this Article shall be null, void, and without effect to the extent permitted by applicable law.

23.4 These protections shall remain in force for the duration of WMMF unless amended in accordance with these Statutes and with the express approval of the Founder.

CHAPTER VIII – FINAL PROVISIONS

Article 24 – Intellectual Property

24.1 All intellectual property rights relating to World Mini Mini Football and WMMF shall remain the exclusive property of WMMF.

24.2 Such intellectual property shall include, but not be limited to:

- a) The name "World Mini Mini Football";
- b) The acronym "WMMF";
- c) Logos, emblems, symbols, and official branding;
- d) Competition names and event titles;
- e) Official Rules of the Game;
- f) Publications, educational materials, and technical documents;
- g) Digital content, media, and audiovisual productions;
- h) Trademarks, copyrights, domain names, and other proprietary rights.

24.3 WMMF may license the use of its intellectual property to Member Associations, Continental Confederations, commercial entities, sponsors, broadcasters, and other authorized parties subject to such terms and conditions as WMMF may determine.

24.4 No license, authorization, or agreement shall transfer ownership of WMMF intellectual property unless expressly approved in accordance with these Statutes.

Article 25 – Amendments

25.1 These Statutes may be amended by Congress in accordance with the procedures established by WMMF.

25.2 Proposed amendments shall be submitted in writing and circulated to eligible voting members prior to the meeting at which they are to be considered.

25.3 Amendments shall require the approval of at least a two-thirds majority of votes cast unless otherwise provided by these Statutes.

25.4 No amendment affecting Founder Protection provisions, ownership of the sport, recognition authority, intellectual property rights, governance structure, or other protected matters shall take effect without the prior approval of the Founder.

25.5 Approved amendments shall enter into force on the date determined by Congress unless otherwise specified.

Article 26 – Dissolution

26.1 WMMF may only be dissolved by a resolution adopted by at least a three-quarters majority of votes cast at a duly convened Congress.

26.2 No proposal for dissolution shall be considered unless notice has been provided to all eligible voting members in advance of the Congress.



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26.3 Any proposal for dissolution shall remain subject to the Founder Protection provisions contained within these Statutes.

26.4 Upon dissolution, the assets, records, intellectual property, and rights of WMMF shall be transferred in accordance with applicable law and any provisions approved by Congress and the Founder.

26.5 Under no circumstances shall the dissolution of WMMF result in the unauthorized transfer of ownership of the sport of World Mini Mini Football.

Article 27 – Entry into Force

27.1 These Statutes shall enter into force immediately upon their adoption by WMMF.

27.2 Upon entry into force, these Statutes shall serve as the supreme governing document of WMMF.

27.3 All Member Associations, officials, athletes, teams, committees, and affiliated entities operating under the authority of WMMF shall be bound by these Statutes and any regulations adopted pursuant to them.

27.4 Any previous constitutional, governance, or regulatory provisions inconsistent with these Statutes shall be superseded from the date these Statutes enter into force.



ANNEX A

RECOGNITION FRAMEWORK FOR MEMBER NATIONAL ASSOCIATIONS

A.1 Recognition Principle

WMMF may recognize one Member Association (MA) in each country, territory, or region as determined by WMMF.

A.2 Eligibility Requirements

An applicant seeking recognition shall:

- a)** Support the objectives and development of World Mini Mini Football;
- b)** Accept and comply with the WMMF Statutes, Regulations, and directives;
- c)** Demonstrate the ability to govern and promote the sport within its jurisdiction;
- d)** Maintain an appropriate organizational structure;
- e)** Operate in a manner consistent with the principles of integrity, fair play, and safeguarding.

A.3 Recognition Process

- a)** Applications shall be submitted to WMMF in the form prescribed by WMMF;
- b)** WMMF may request additional information or documentation;
- c)** Recognition shall be granted solely at the discretion of WMMF;
- d)** Recognition may be provisional or full.

A.4 Rights of Recognized Member Associations

Recognized Member Associations may:

- a)** Represent their jurisdiction within WMMF;
- b)** Participate in WMMF competitions and activities;
- c)** Use approved WMMF branding and intellectual property in accordance with applicable regulations.

A.5 Withdrawal of Recognition

WMMF may suspend or withdraw recognition where a Member Association:

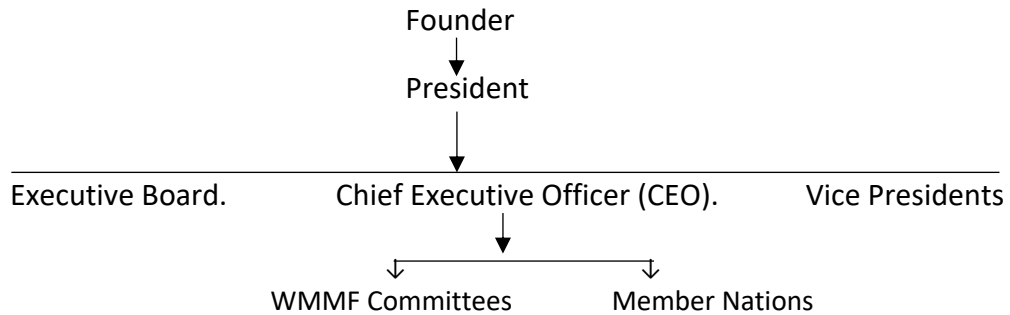
- a)** Violates WMMF Statutes or Regulations;
- b)** Fails to fulfill its obligations;
- c)** Acts contrary to the interests of the sport or WMMF.

ANNEX C FOUNDER PROTECTION FRAMEWORK

C.1 Purpose

The Founder Protection Framework exists to preserve the ownership, identity, governance, and independence of World Mini Mini Football (WMMF).

C.2 Protected Matters

The following shall be protected matters:

- a) Ownership of the sport;
- b) Official Rules of the Game;
- c) Recognition authority over Member Associations;
- d) WMMF name, trademarks, and intellectual property;
- e) World Championships and official competitions;
- f) Founder Protection provisions;
- g) Governance structure of WMMF.

C.3 Founder Approval

No protected matter may be:

- a) Sold;
 - b) Transferred;
 - c) Assigned;
 - d) Surrendered;
 - e) Materially altered;
- without the prior written approval of the Founder.

C.4 Invalid Actions

Any action or agreement contrary to this Framework shall be considered invalid and without effect under WMMF governance.



ANNEX D

DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATIONS

D.1 Definitions

For the purposes of these Statutes:

- I.** WMMF means the World Mini Mini Football Federation.
- II.** Founder means the creator and owner of the sport of World Mini Mini Football and the individual granted authority under these Statutes.
- III.** The President means President of WMMF
- IV.** CEO means the Chief Executive Officer of WMMF.
- V.** Executive Board means the board appointed in accordance with these Statutes.
- VI.** Member Association (MA) means an organization recognized by WMMF to govern the sport within a country, territory, or region.
- VII.** COmmittes mean WMMF Committees
- VIII.** Competition means any event, championship, league, tournament, match, or activity sanctioned by WMMF.
- IX.** Regulations means rules, policies, directives, codes, procedures, and other governance documents adopted by WMMF.

D.2 Interpretation

- a)** Words importing the singular shall include the plural and vice versa where the context permits;
- b)** Headings are for convenience only and shall not affect interpretation;
- c)** References to one gender shall include all genders;
- d)** In the event of uncertainty regarding interpretation, the Founder shall have final authority to determine the meaning and intent of these Statutes.
